- To enter this competition, you must submit a video entry to us via an unlisted YouTube link or Vimeo. The camera should not move, and the video must be a non-edited continuous film. This video should be no older than 6 months old and show a true representation of your skills. Video entry time limits can be found in your category information.
- Your entry is only confirmed when the entry form is submitted, video entry has been emailed to unitedaerialac@gmail.com and the entry fee has been paid.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.

- Video entries open on 1st October and close on 12th November. We will announce finalists via social media on WC 18th December.
- Competitors are to ensure they have entered the correct category for their age and circumstances. This will be checked by the organisers of the competition and if they believe someone is in the wrong category, they will contact you to change. For aged categories you must go by the competitors age for the final.
- Competitors must stick to the time limits given for your category. There will be a 5 second waiver before points are deducted.
- Music must be edited to the correct time limit, music will not be faded out for the live event by the competition organisers. Song choices must be age appropriate and have no swearing.
- The final will be held on 3rd March 2024 at The Halesowen Town Hall, Halesowen Town Centre, B63 3AF. By entering this competition, you are agreeing to being available to compete for your title.
- For the live final we will have a 95mm fire toys tabless aerial hoop connected to a 2M strop and a low stretch prodigy fire toys silk connected to a figure 8. You are permitted to use your own equipment however this must be able to be rigged to a single point and will be safety checked. If the riggers believe the equipment is unsafe you will not be able to perform at the live final on the equipment you have provided however you can use the competition equipment.
- All youth and amateur competitors must use a crash mat which will be provided. Instructor and professional categories can choose. If you choose not to use a crash mat, you will be asked to provide proof of insurance before the live final.
- Competitors taking part are acknowledging the risks taken in competing. The Competition organisers will not take any responsibility for injuries during the live final.
- It is the competitor's own responsibility to warm up and cool down.
- Competitors should not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs. The organisers have the right to disqualify anyone they believe to be under the influence.
- Competitors should act in a professional manner. Any inappropriate or unprofessional behaviour from competitor's will be disqualified and asked to leave the competition.
- Props for the live final must be pre-arranged and agreed by the competition organisers.
- Judges have the right to stop any performances they believe unsafe. The routine will not be allowed to be re done.
- The judge's choice is final. You can query any feedback via unitedaerialac@gmail.com after the event.

- Tickets for the final will be sold via our website. Entry will not be allowed without a ticket. Competitor's do not need a ticket.
- Images and videos taken on the live final may be used for promotional purposes. Any competitors who wish to not be posted must notify the competition organisers prior to the live event.
